

NORTHEASTERN SASI RULES

Do not ride in any vehicle or with anyone other than SASI Staff in SASI provided transportation.

Turn in your automobile keys to Assistant Director Irene Cannon by Sunday 5:00 PM.

Always travel in-groups of THREE or more, never alone.

Beepers and phones [cell and others] may remain on during breaks, social time at dorms, and before lights out times. Phones [cell or other] are to be used at specified times only. Phones are to be OFF during sessions. Violations of above expectations will have the phone held by the administration until Thursday dismissal time.

iPods, nanos, etc. are not to be in use during sessions but can be used during free time where acceptable. Violations will be treated the same as above.

Hats, headgear, sunshades or sunglasses will not be worn inside buildings.

Appropriate attire will be worn to all sessions of SASI, [No advertising of ATOD, violence, etc]

No use, possession, sell, or transfer of tobacco, alcohol, illicit or illegal drugs during the SASI Experience.

Be respectful of fellow SASI campers and staff, ECU students, staff and administration.

Be on your floor/suite by 11:00pm each night. No excuses.

Be in your rooms by 11:30pm each night doors closed. No excuses.

You are expected to be in your dorm room from 11:30pm to 6:00am each night/day. No student athlete or junior counselor is allowed out of his/her suite/room or in lobby/basement between 11:00 PM and 6:45AM.

Hold down your noise in the dorms to a minimum. Everyone may not appreciate your music/ voice.

Violation of SASI or ECU rules and regulations may result in notification of parents and your removal from the camp.

Boys are only allowed on the boy's floor/wing and girls are only allowed on the girl's floor/wing. You may socialize with each other in the designated lobby/basement/courtyard during appropriate times.

Be on time and prepared for all sessions, this is never a problem for student leaders. Your SASI backpack, folder and pen/pencil are a must. Wear your lanyard & nametag to all class sessions and activities.

Do not misplace your meal card or you will be very hungry.

Sleeping, slumping in your seats, and putting your head down on your desk will not be tolerated in sessions.

Profanity or vulgarity is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.

A SASI Staff person must accompany any student athlete or junior counselor outside the dorm after dark. No exceptions.

You are a positive role model and you will be expected to lead by example. Therefore-- **our standards, set standards!**

Strive for excellence at all times, not perfection.
