PASSES: Each school will receive 5 complimentary wristbands. Please fax a list of the

names that should receive the complimentary tickets to (919) 240-7396. Please have people on the complimentary list identify themselves at

the pass gate. We must receive by no later than 10 am, Thursday morning.

OFFICIALS: Three officials will be assigned for the championship game through the state

office. There will be a pre-game conference 30 minutes before game time. The director, NCHSAA representative, the three officials and the two coaches will meet at the game site. During the pre-game conference, team introduction procedure, pre-game staging, overtime procedure, clock, substitution procedure

and post ceremonies will be discussed.

sole responsibility of NCHSAA Staff.

TRAINER: Athletic trainers will be provided by Carolina Family Practice & Sports

Medicine; however, participating schools are encouraged to bring their own. Be certain to bring all medical release forms to Wake Med Soccer Park to insure that

students will be able to receive necessary medical treatment.

PRE-GAME

SUPERVISION: Please make plans to have an administrator on the sideline with your team and

also have administrators on spectator side (ground level) to assist with crowd control. We need your assistance in helping to keep your spectators off the playing field at the conclusion of the game (please report to the field area in front of your crowd 5 minutes prior to the end of the game). A committee for selection needs to be appointed by the tournament director.

Directions to WakeMed Soccer Park

From Interstate 40 Eastbound (From Chapel Hill, Durham) Take the Cary 54 exit (exit 290) off Interstate 40. Turn right at the top of the exit ramp, heading toward Cary. Turn left onto Southeast Maynard Road. Take a left on Chatham Street after crossing the railroad tracks. WakeMed Soccer Park is 1/2 mile on the right.

From Interstate 40 Westbound (From Fayetteville, Wilmington) Take exit 291 (Cary Towne Boulevard) Turn right onto Cary Town Boulevard Turn right onto Southeast Maynard Road. Turn right onto East Chatham Street. WakeMed Soccer Park will be one-half mile on the right.

From Downtown Cary Head east on Chatham Street toward Raleigh. WakeMed Soccer Park will be on the right.

From Raleigh/Beltline From the Beltline, take the Western Boulevard exit and head west toward Cary. Continue after the merger with Hillsborough Street until the road becomes East Chatham Street. WakeMed Soccer Park will be on the left, one-half mile before the Maynard Road intersection.
