- NO PETS are allowed
- NO bikes, skates, skateboards, rollerblades permitted inside of the park
- DO NOT leave children unattended without adult supervision
- NO overnight camping
- NO open flames or portable generators
- Ice, cups and water coolers will be provided
- Team coolers must come in with the team.
- Ticket sales will begin one hour and half prior to first game each day.
- Game ticket is \$8.00 at gate. Children 5 and under admitted free.

- \$5.00 fee for parking.
- There will be **NO PASSES OUT** during games. Re-entry requires buying another ticket.
- Tickets are non-refundable.
- If a third game is necessary on Saturday, the stadium will be cleared and new ticket sold.
- Concession stands will be open.
- Each team will be allowed 5 complimentary passes; fax names to 919-240-7398 by Thursday @ 10:00AM. Names will be left at the main entrance.

- Parking will be available at the site (map will be provided by email)
- Sunday, June 8 will be used only as a make-up date.
- No banners may be hung in the seating area.
- No body paint!
- Carolina Family Practice & Sports Medicine of Wake County will provide the trainer(s) for the series. Each team is encouraged to bring their trainer.
- Raleigh Parks and Recreation will provide gators to transport handicapped and/or elderly to the fields. Pick-up will be located at the tent on road level at main entrance. Pick-up from inside the park will be located at the backside of the tower (opposite front entrance side).
- Tents may not be set up in bleachers and if used, must be on far end of bleachers down each baseline.
- Umbrellas or tents may not be used between dugouts and backstop or behind the backstop.
- No generators or electrical devices allowed in the dugouts.
- No filming or videotaping past 1st or 3rd bases or in the outfields behind the fence except for approved TV stations.
- Bus parking will be in the first tier/section (right side) upon entering.
- Teams that travel to Raleigh early and need a practice facility must call (919) 807-5405 to request a practice time and field. No practice will take place on the assigned playing fields prior to games.

- Neutral officials have been assigned to all games.
- Protest Committee: Competing Schools will provide 2 people for the protest committee and the 5th impartial person will be on site. This committee's decision is final.
- A special committee will also select the MVP.
- There will be a total of 25 medals presented. If you need additional medals please contact Mort's at (919) 828-2887.
- All teams must participate in the awards ceremony. A special Sportsmanship Award will be presented to a player from each team prior to the first game.
