

## SUMMARY OF SPECTATOR INFORMATION/PARKING MAP

### NCHSAA State Football Championships

*Spectators will not be allowed to bring coolers or food containers into the stadium.*

*All bags are subject to being searched.*

*Body/Face Paint is not allowed!!!! (Small face decals are permitted)*

*Please enter at the appropriate gate for the seating area:*

Sections 11- 20 of the stadium (**non-Deacon Tower side**) will be used for spectator seating of **Western** teams. Those with presale tickets should enter through **Gate 3**; disability seating available in Sections 11, 12, 13, 17, and 18.

Those needing to purchase tickets can do so at Bridger Field House ticket windows, and then enter at **Gate 3**.

Sections 1-10 of the stadium (**Deacon Tower side**) are for spectators of **Eastern** teams. Those with presale tickets should enter through **Gate 2**; disability seating available in Sections 8, 9, & 10. Those needing to purchase tickets on game day can do so at Bridger Field House ticket windows then enter at **Gate 2**.

Western Teams are **Visitors** – Eastern Teams are **Home**

**Pre-sale - \$9.00            Game Day - \$10.00**

**(Presale tickets available only at participating schools)**

**NO RE-ADMITTANCE!** Price of the ticket entitles the bearer to admission for all day. However, no one will be re-admitted after leaving the stadium.

**Public Parking**

Available in the Blue, Red, Orange, and Gold Lots; Disability parking available in Gold and Red Lots.

Gold, Red, Blue, and Orange **Parking Lots open @ 8:30AM; Tailgating is welcomed!**

***Parking fee: \$10 for cars; \$20 for buses***

**Band Seating**

Eastern Bands – Section 3

Western Bands – Section 18

***NO spectators will be allowed on the field at any time!***

The non-Deacon Tower Side of the stadium will be used for spectators of **Western Teams**.

The Deacon Tower Side will be spectator seating for the **Eastern teams**.

Eastern Teams are **HOME** -- Western Teams are **Visitors**

***Spectators are not allowed on the field following the game.***

On Saturday, each 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> game team will have 30 minutes to vacate the locker room following the game. This will allow ample time for the next team to enter.

**Each team is responsible for seeing that locker rooms are left in order. Schools will be responsible for any damage.**

Each school is responsible for the conduct of players, cheerleaders, band members and spectators from the time they arrive on campus until the time they depart for home.

No Re-admittance will be allowed. One ticket will entitle the bearer to see 3 games; however, **it will not allow for leaving the stadium and then returning.**

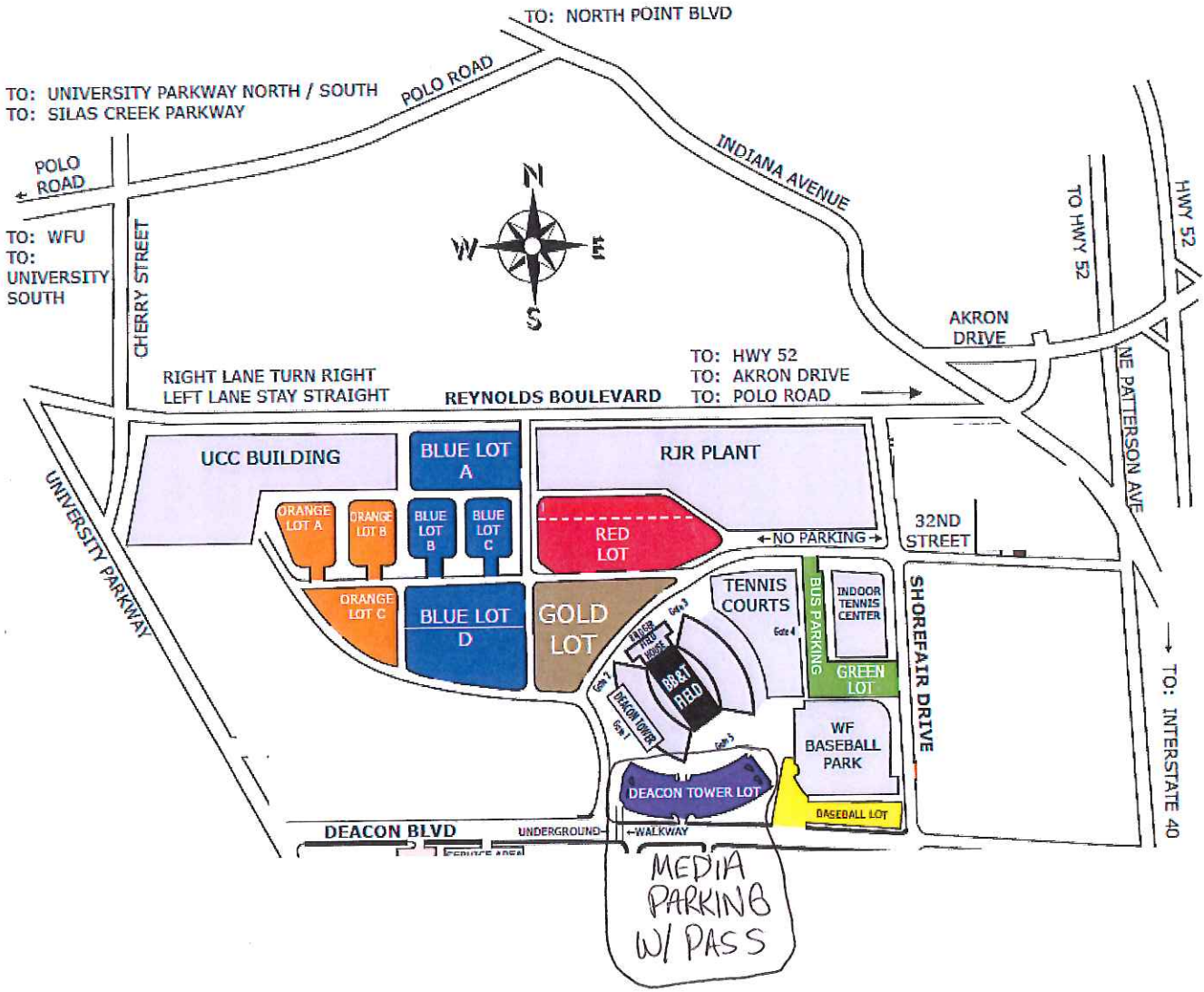
Parking information has been provided for you to distribute to your spectators as you sell presale tickets. Please be sure that this information is available to them.
