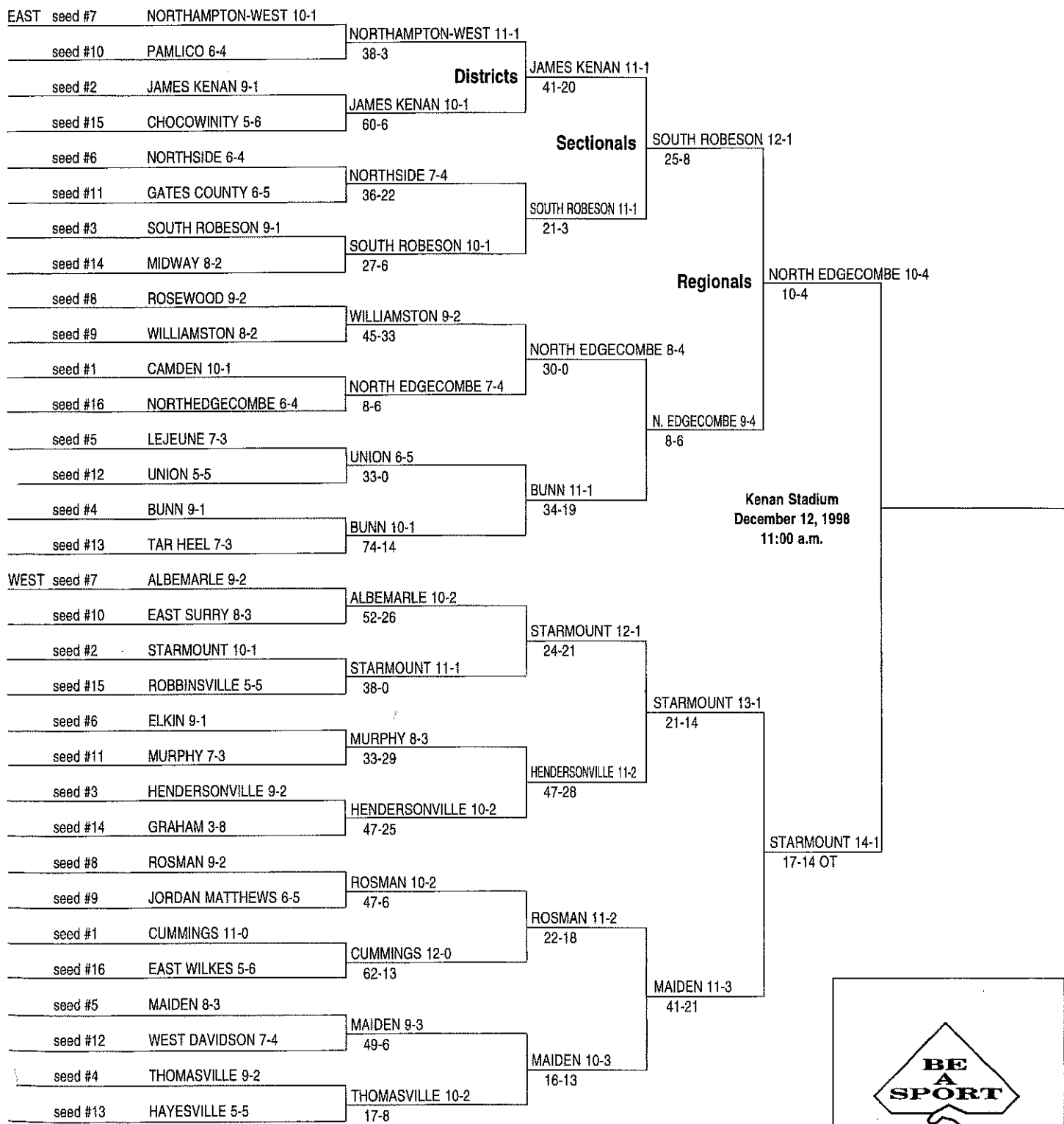




HOW THEY GOT HERE: CLASS 1A
