



2018 NCHSAA VOLLEYBALL PLAYOFF CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

CHAPEL HILL - The North Carolina High School Athletic Association (NCHSAA) finalized and released the playoff brackets for the 2018 Volleyball Championships. The tournament will have four classifications of play with six playoff rounds each. The 4A brackets will field 48 teams each with 1A, 2A and 3A brackets fielding 64 teams each.

Play began with games at the higher seed through the first five rounds beginning with first round contests on October 23rd. Second round is scheduled for October 25th, the third round is slated for October 27th, fourth round games October 30th and the Regional Finals scheduled to be held on Thursday, November 1st.

The State Championship Matches will be contested on Saturday, November 3rd in Raleigh at NC State University's historic Reynolds Coliseum. Play is scheduled to begin at 12 noon. Tickets to the Championships are \$10.00 at the door, or digital tickets can be purchased in advance through the NCHSAA's partnership with GoFan.

The 2017 NCHSAA Volleyball Championships were the first championships in any NCHSAA sport broadcast live via web stream on the NFHS Network and the Network will again carry all four championship matches this year. The NFHS Network is a subscription-based service. Fans can pay \$9.95 per month for a monthly, recurring subscription with the ability to cancel at any time. HIGH SCHOOL HAPPENS HERE

2018 NCHSAA VOLLEYBALL PLAYOFFS SECOND ROUND HIGHLIGHTS

ONE AWAY FROM 100

- Hendersonville secured the program's 99th win in the state playoffs with a five-set second round match victory against Brevard. The Bearcats will look to make history as the first program to reach the 100 playoff win plateau when they face Mount Pleasant on the road on Saturday in the third round.

OTHER MILESTONE WINS

- 4A West #12 seed Providence won the school's 80th playoff match when they knocked off the #5 seed Hickory Ridge 3-0. Providence has amassed the wins in just 30 appearances (including this year) in the tournament.
- 2A West #4 seed West Davidson secured their 50th win in the playoffs with a 3-0 defeat of #13 West Stanly. West Davidson has compiled 50 wins in 28 tournament appearances.
- 2A West #14 seed West Iredell earned their 50th playoff win with a 3-0 victory over #3 East Lincoln. West Iredell has appeared in the NCHSAA playoffs in 27 years.

STREAKS CONTINUE

- Three teams won back-to-back volleyball state championships a season ago. Green Hope, Carrboro and Community School of Davidson all earned a second straight championship in 2017. Their playoff winning streaks continue now as they moved into the third round.

2018 NCHSAA VOLLEYBALL PLAYOFFS FIRST ROUND MILESTONES

NEW QUEEN OF THE KILL

- Vance County's Emani' Foster set a new state record for kills in a single match with 57 as she led her team to a five-set win over East Duplin in the 2A playoffs. Foster broke her own record, set last year while she was at Northern Vance, of 48 kills in a match against J.F. Webb on September 7, 2017. She finished the season last year with 598 kills, the second-highest total in NCHSAA history, behind only Enka's Taylor Sauer who amassed 602 in 2012.

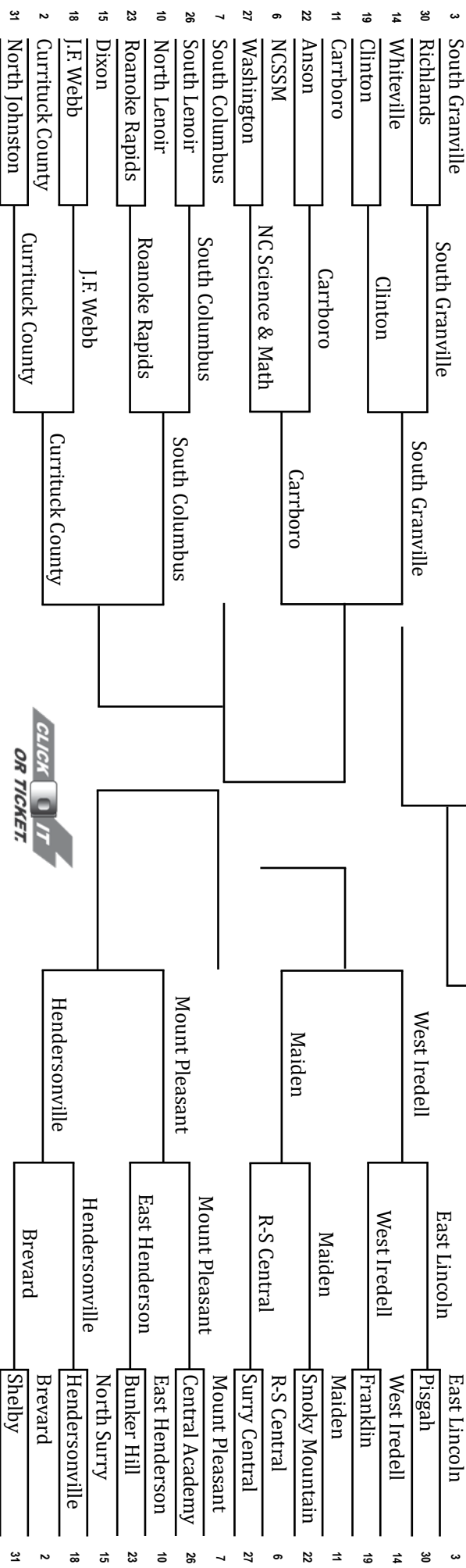

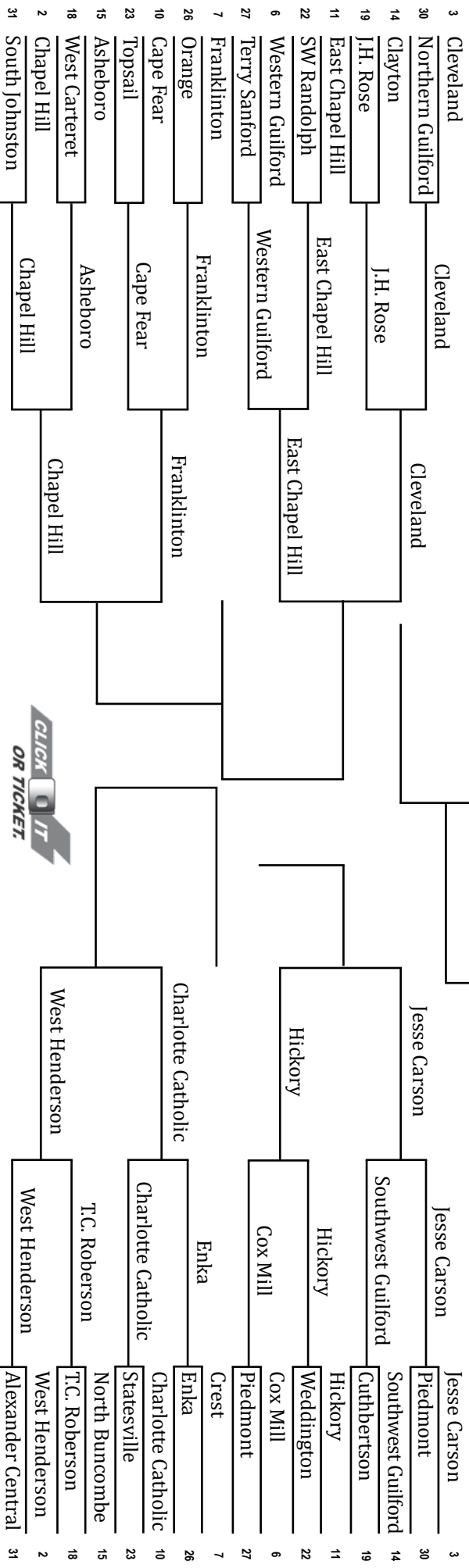

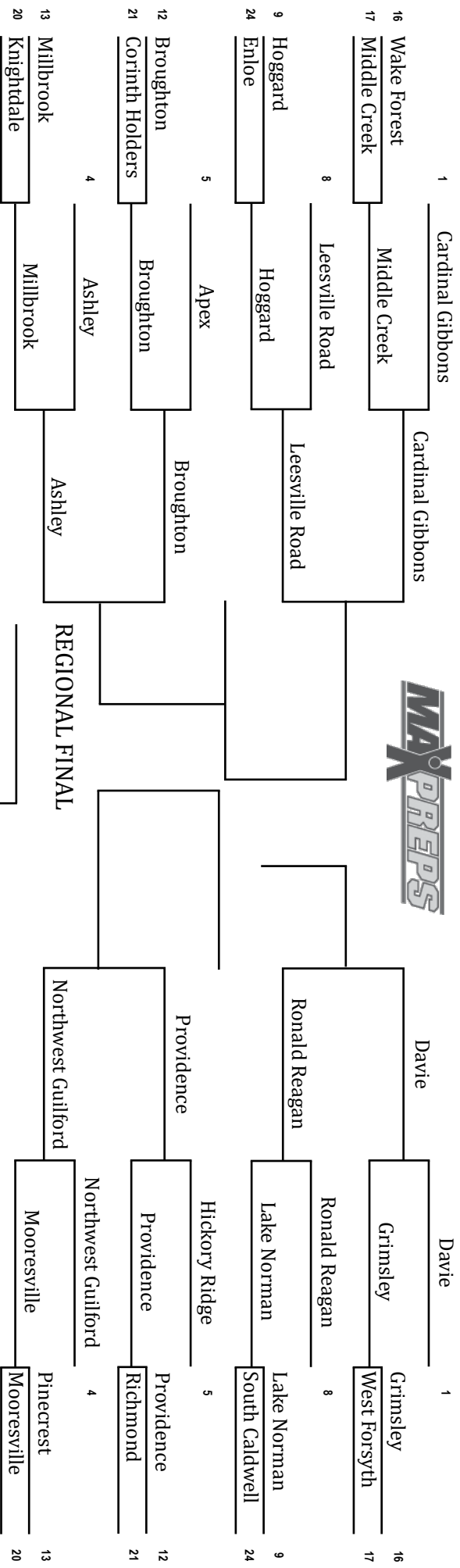

1-A: COMMUNITY SCHOOL OF DAVIDSON CLAIMS FIRST CROWN 3-0 OVER LOUISBURG

RALEIGH – After giving up the first five points of the match to Louisburg, the Community School of Davidson Spartans rallied back to nab the lead in the opening set 11-10. They did not look back, pushing on to take the first set 25-18 before sweeping the next two sets and claiming the school's first State Championship in volleyball.

RALEIGH – Carrboro won the school's first volleyball state championship by a three-games to one count over Maiden, completing an undefeated season. The Jaguars were led by the 2A Championship M.V.P. Destiny Cox, who had 16 kills on the day in four sets and drew a lot of attention from the Maiden defense all match long.

The Jaguars fell behind early in the first set as Maiden jumped out to an 8-4 advantage before the Jags found their footing and tied the set at 12. Then Carrboro edged in front for the first time at 21-20 before closing out the set without allowing another point at 25-20.

Carrboro cruised through set two, winning the set easily 25-17. Maiden would not go down without a fight as the Blue Devils showed a lot of heart in building a 14-11 lead in the third set before ripping off a 25-18 victory, closing out the set on a tap down at the net by two-time Southern District 7 2A player of the year, Holland Laxton.

3-A: COX MILL SWEEPS THROUGH CHAPEL HILL TO WIN FIRST CHAMPIONSHIP

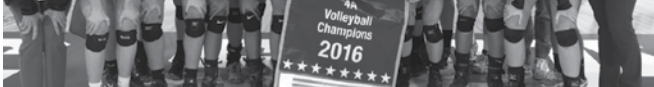

Reagan finished the year at 30-3, and advancing to the school's first state championship appearance. The Raiders were led by Hunter Beem who amassed 13 kills with just two errors. Jenna Robbins addend 11 kills and Bailey Hatchett chipped in 10 kills.
