

NCHSAA Pole Vault Check-in Procedures

Regular Season – State Championships

Regular Season – Regionals:

- 1. Pole Vault competitors must be weighed on a scale at the meet site.
 - a. Please do not ask the athletes their weight or try to guess their weight.
- 2. Pole Vault Competitors' poles must be checked at the same site and time that the competitor is weighed.
- 3. Poles must be verified and marked in bright visible colored tape.
- 4. The pole vault official must initial and date the tape after it is placed on the pole.
- 5. The head coach must place their initials by the student-athletes name on the pole vault form.
- 6. Any pole that does not pass an inspection must be placed in a secure location and picked up after the track meet. Schools should have the option to place the pole back on the bus.

Note: Upon request, host schools should be able to provide the NCHSAA with a copy of proof of the above information.

State Championships:

- 1. Poles will be verified, and student-athletes will be weighed at the state track meet.
- 2. Pole Vault coaches will check in with the pole vault referee to obtain a pass to be allowed access to the field.
- 3. All pole vault coaches must be listed on a school's master eligibility list to be able to obtain a pass.
- 4. One coach's pass per athlete.
