# Preparation for Seeding

- Make sure all scrimmages and jamborees have been removed from your MaxPreps schedule
- Make sure that all matches have been entered (best of three or best of five)
- Make sure that conference tournaments are entered as conference tournament
- Make sure all ties are broken from first place to last place

# Playoffs

- Schools must maintain seating for participants and spectators, with one-third (1/3) of the available seating reserved for the visiting team's spectators.
- The NCHSAA reserves the right to require host teams in the playoffs to find an adequate facility based on expected attendance or quality of venue (Handbook Rule 2.2.3 (d)).

# Playoffs

- **Schools are responsible for entering/updating their game times on the brackets via DragonFly**
- Contests may not be played after the date listed for each round unless postponed due to inclement weather but may be played earlier by mutual agreement of the participating schools
- **The default game time is 7:00 p.m.**
- By mutual agreement a game time of 6:00 p.m. is permissible.
- Game time will be 6:00 p.m. if the visiting team is over 100 miles one-way.
- **Saturdays** - Games may be played at any time if mutually agreed upon.
  - *If teams cannot mutually agree, the higher-seeded team may choose a starting time between 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.*
  - Between 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. if the visiting team is over 100 miles one-way.

# Playoffs

## Officials

- *Line Judges may be used during rounds 1-4 upon mutual agreement*
- The participating schools may decide who will serve in these positions and absorb any fees associated with the payment of these individuals
- **Line Judges MUST be used during the regional round and will be assigned by the regional supervisor assigned to the contest**
- The fees associated with the payment of these officials are an allowable expense to be included on the financial report form

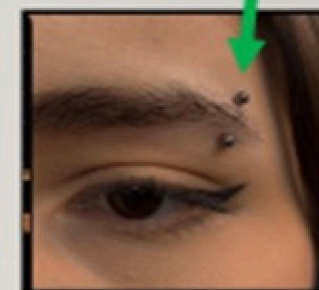
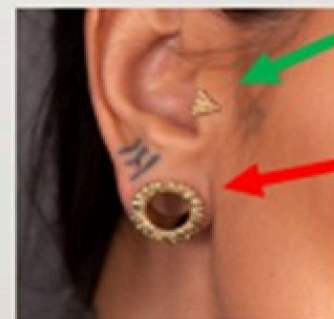
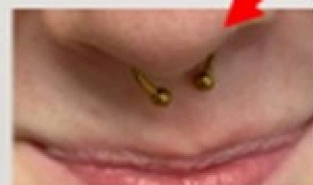
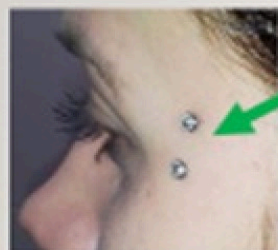
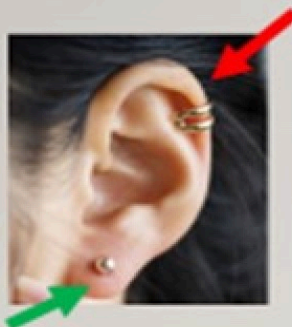
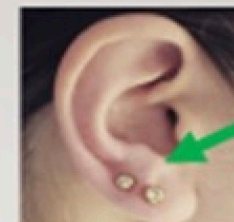
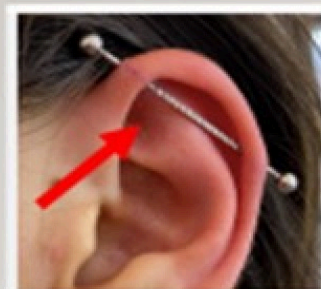
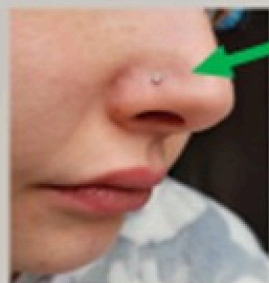
# Officials

Rounds	Officials Association
1 <sup>st</sup> – 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Assigned by local officials' association of the host school
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 4 <sup>th</sup>	Neutral or mutually agreed upon official's association – host school to secure the local association/officials
Regional	Assigned by NCHSAA office
State	Assigned by NCHSAA office

# Hair

- ❖ NFHS Rule:
- ❖ 4-1-6(a):
  - Hair-control devices and other adornments in the hair that are securely fastened and do not present an increased risk to the player, teammates, or opponents are allowed.
- ❖ 4-1-8.... Players shall not wear body paint or glitter on their hair, face, uniform, or body.
