### Meet Guidelines

- **No deck changing** will be allowed. Athletes must use the locker rooms. The penalty for deck changing before, during or after a meet is disqualification of a competitor from further competition in the meet, to include all events in which the competitor previously qualified (unsporting conduct). (Rule 3.6.1)
- **No Shaving** will be permitted on site.
- No body art except for the event, heat and lane number is permitted on swimmers. Tattoos are permissible as long as they are not offensive in the opinion of the Meet Referee.
- At no time may a swimmer enter the competition pool without the permission of the deck referee.
- No compression tape may be worn by an athlete unless a written note from a doctor/health professional indicating it is for an injury is delivered to the Meet Referee prior to the beginning of the meet. Any tape on athletes should be presented to the Meet Referee prior to the meet for approval.
- Only one suit may be worn in competition; drag suits are not allowed in competition and undergarments are not permitted unless the state association has provided written permission.
- Please ask your team parents and swimmers to refrain from flash photography at the start.
- Results will be posted on the pool deck and in the spectator area.
- No chairs or sitting on the deck unless against the wall or behind the columns.
- Please keep your team area clean and insure that the athletes respect the facilities provided by the Triangle Aquatic Center.
- Teams may not enter the water or throw coach in pool in celebration.
- A DFS may be taken for an entered event (the Meet Referee or deck referee must be notified prior to the start of the event) or the swimmer may be scratched by notifying the Admin Referee prior to the event being called. In both cases, the entry counts as an event for the swimmer.
- A swimmer who fails to take a DFS or fails to scratch and is a No Show for an event shall be disqualified from further competition in the meet (including relays).

- Whistle starts and no recall protocols will be used.
- Dual confirmation of false starts and relay take-offs protocols will be followed.
- Backstrokers must “step in” for backstroke and the medley relay events. Jumping in is considered a false start (Rule 8.1.3b).
- We will NOT be doing dive-overs. All swimmers, including the last relay swimmer, please exit the pool promptly at the end of each heat.
- This meet has been designated a “USA Swimming Observed Meet”. Times achieved by USA Swimming members will be uploaded to the USA Swimming database (SWIMS). All USA Swimming athletes should submit this form to facilitate uploading of times:

### Relay Guidelines

- Relay cards will be in your packet on arrival.
- Turn in your cards with correct relay names to the Admin Referee at the scoring table prior to the end of warm-ups; name changes or changes in order may be made to the Admin Referee at the scoring table (forms available at the admin table) before completion of the relay heat.
- Boys’ relays will not be permitted to go behind the blocks until the last heat of girls relays are in the water.

### Scoring and Advancement to 4A State Championship

- Individual Scoring will be as follows:
  - 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Relays are double points.
- The winning and runner up teams will receive plaques.
- The top 6 times will qualify for the state championship. Competitors must achieve the regional qualifying time to advance to state. The next 6 overall (from all regionals) will also advance to states. If two swimmers/relays tie for 6<sup>th</sup>, there will be a swim off. Swim-off times will not be used for at-large qualifying. Ties for 24<sup>th</sup> (at large) will qualify for state championships.
- Individuals and relay teams who qualify for State Championship and do not intend to participate must notify the Regional Meet Director, Mandy McMillan ([mcmillanmandyp@gmail.com](mailto:mcmillanmandyp@gmail.com)) by 3:00pm on the Monday before State Competition.
- Event alternates will not advance after that time and it will count as entry for that athlete.  
*(Note- Athletes may scratch from a single event without scratching from the meet.)*
- Substitutes for relay participants are allowed.
