

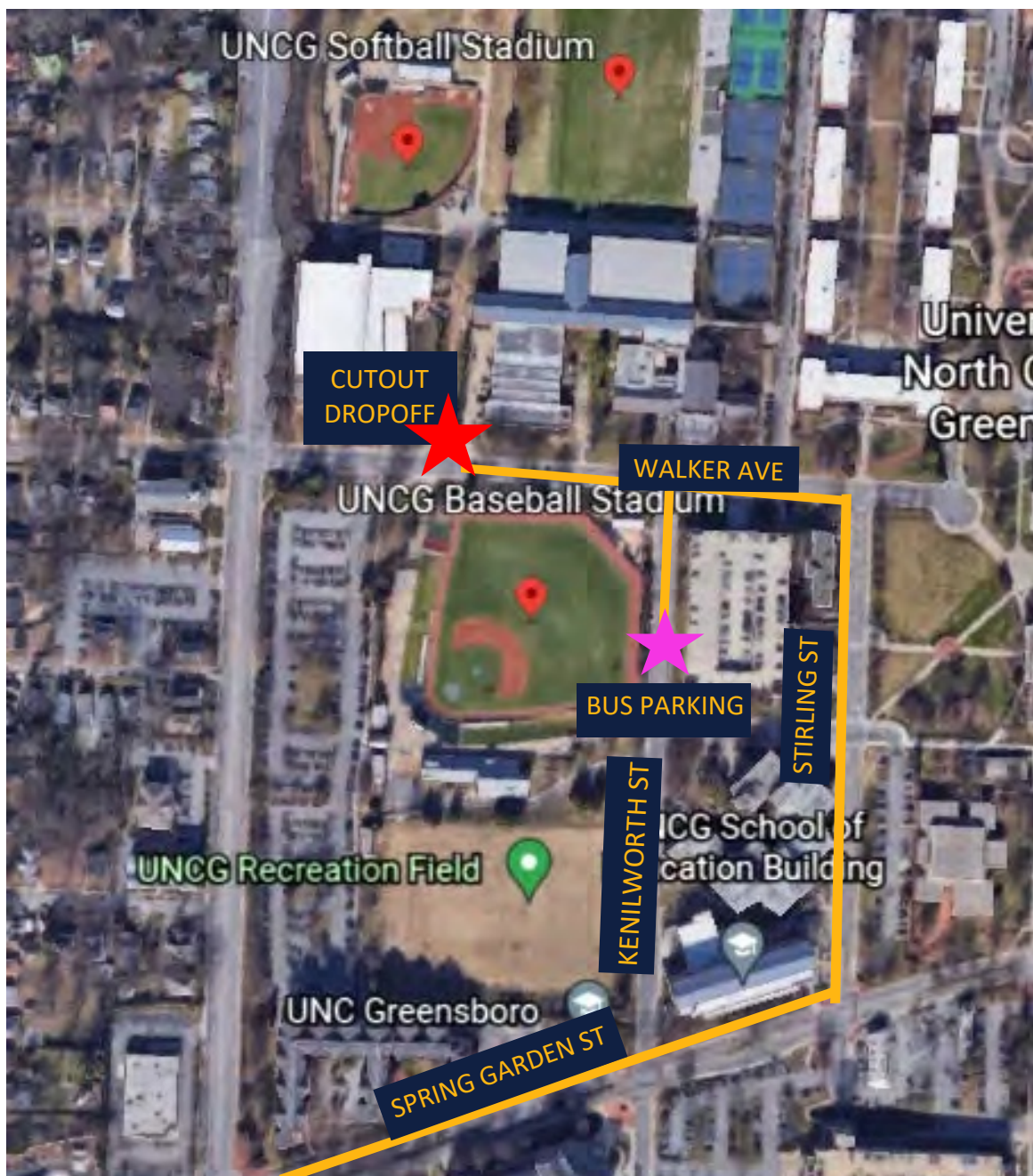
Parking Information - UNCG Softball Stadium

GPS Address to UNCG Softball Stadium: 1408 Walker Ave., Greensboro, NC 27402

Driving Notice: The train bridge at Josephine Boyd Street (11'9"), Tate Street (11'11"), and Chapman Street (12'9") may be too low for your bus to travel under. Teams should use Wendover Avenue to Spring Garden Street (when coming from the west) or Spring Garden Street (from Downtown).

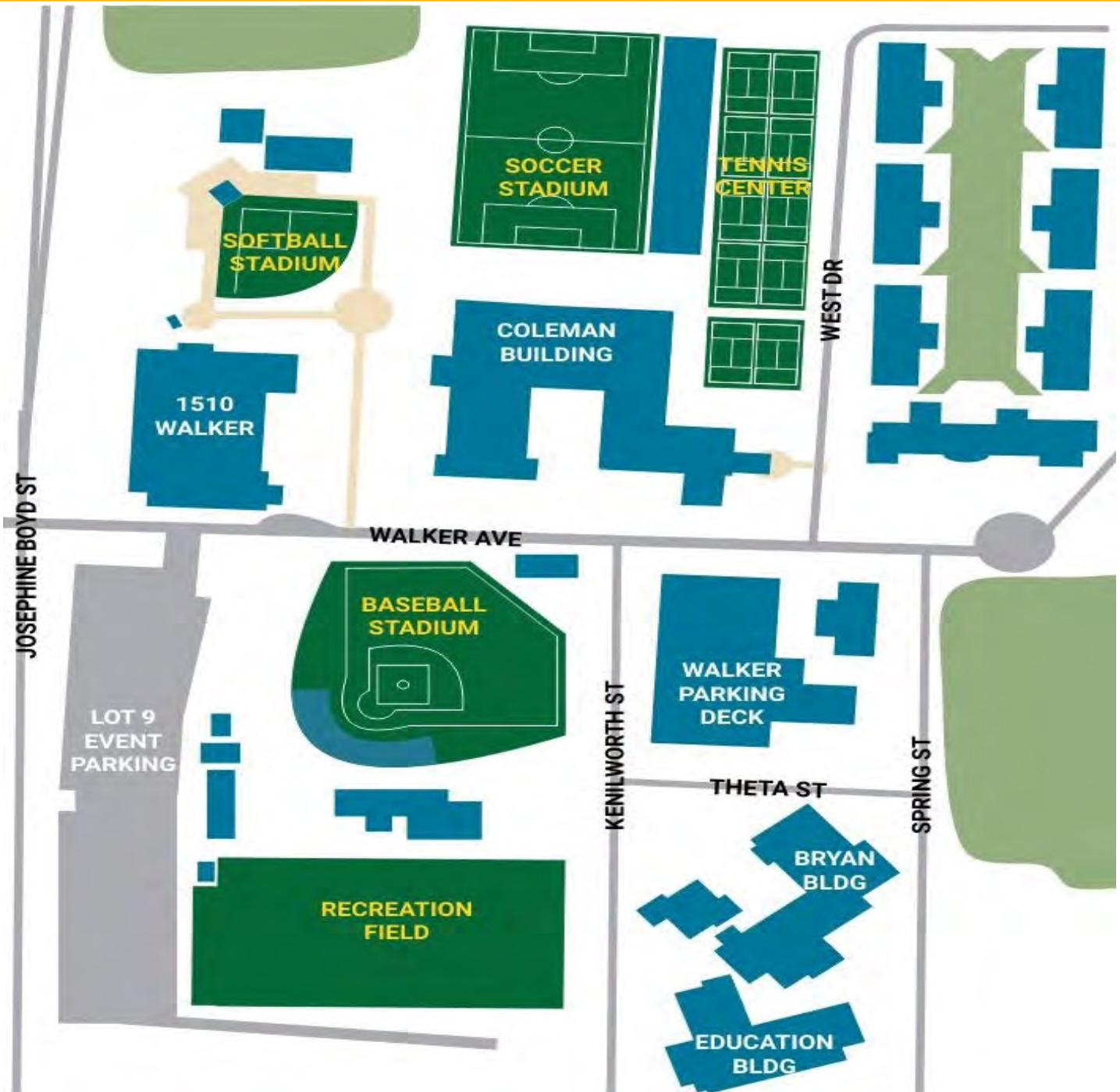
Teams should drop off and pick up in the cutout at Walker Ave. All buses and other team vehicles must proceed to park outside the Baseball Field on Kenilworth Street. Please park on the right side of the road.

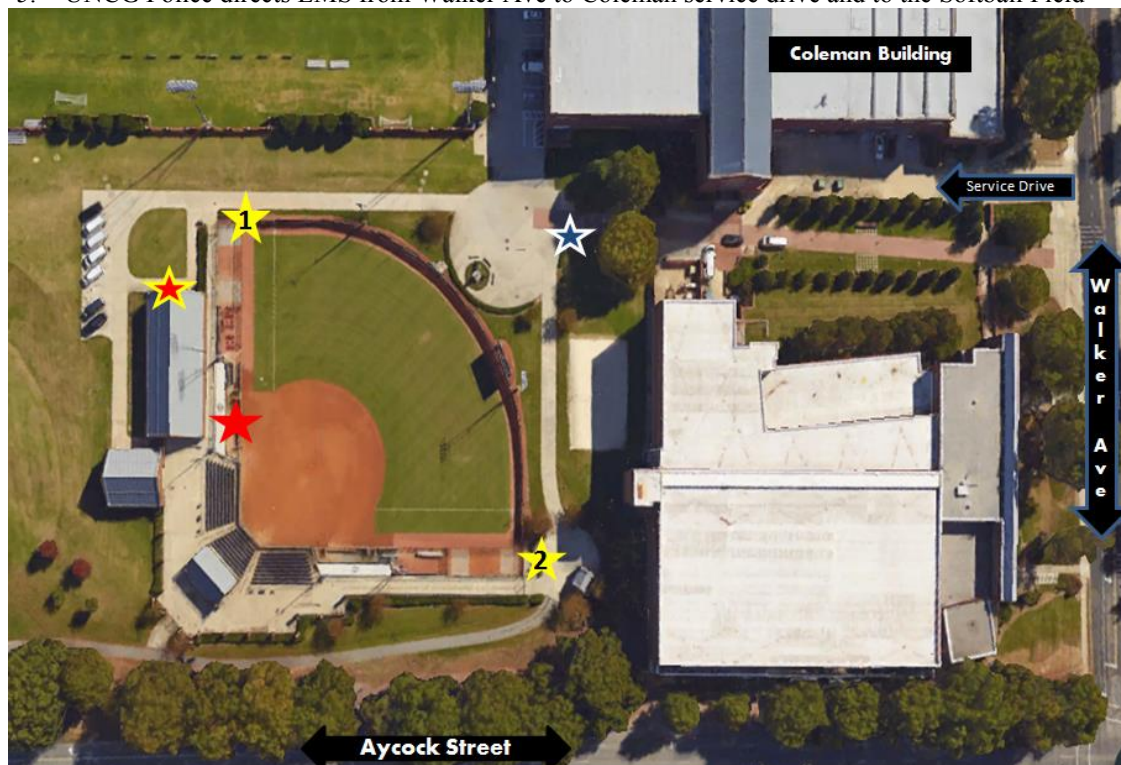

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

1. AT/ATS/Coach performs primary assessment to determine activation status
2. AT/ATS/Coach radios UNCG Police Dispatch (Channel 6) via two way radio, cellular telephone 336.334.4444 or blue emergency call box ★ to activate EMS.
3. AT/ATS radios Event Management (Game Only) to notify that EMS has been activated and appropriate access necessary; radios remain on channel for further communication. Event Management will ensure that Campus Police is aware of situation.
4. AT/Coach unlocks appropriate gates.
5. UNCG Police directs EMS from Walker Ave to Coleman service drive and to the Softball Field
