Jeff Hartley of West Davidson caught every inning of every game his team played during his high school career (1994, 24 games and 167 innings; 1995, 25 games and 179 innings; 1996, 24 games and 162 innings; 1997, 20 games and 137 innings. Total 93 games and 645 innings. He always wanted to pitch, so the coach let him pitch the final out of his career.

Todd Matthews of Overhills played all nine positions in a game between Overhills and Fayetteville Westover on March 25, 2011. Matthews either was officially credited with a putout or played at least two outs of an inning at every position. Overhills won the game in six innings, called as a result of the 10-run rule, 12-2. Matthews was an all-conference catcher as a freshman in 2010.

Travis Long of Fuquay-Varina also played all nine positions in a game between Fuquay-Varina and Garner on April 7, 2011. He drove in a run in the bottom of the fifth inning in the 15-5 game shortened by the 10-run rule.
