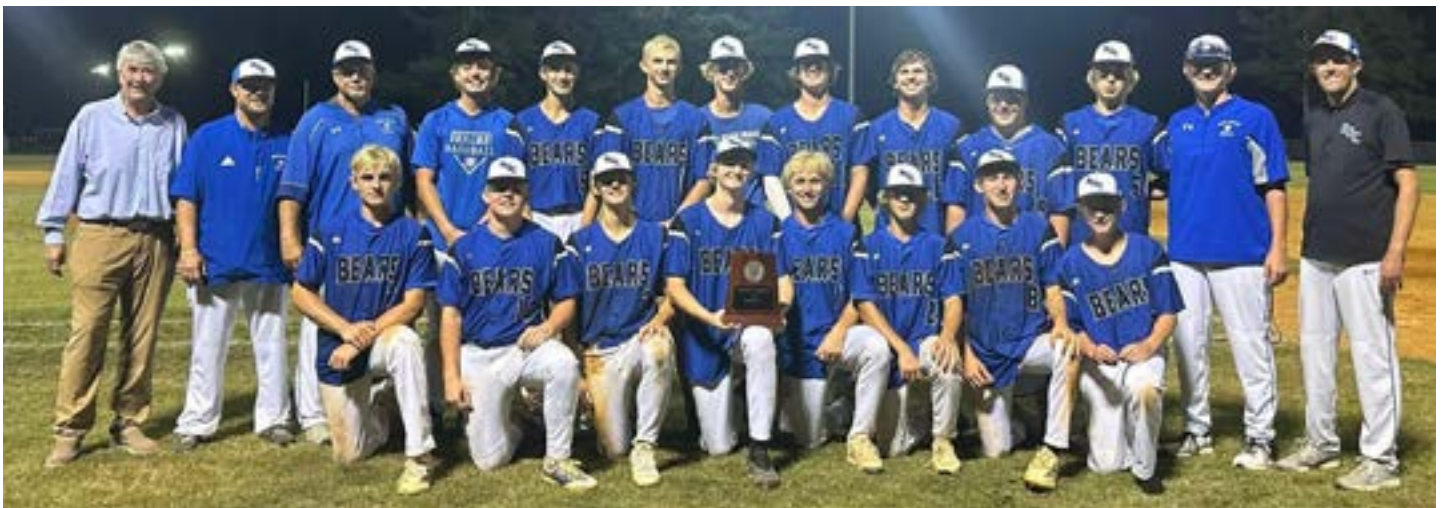
Keys to success this season

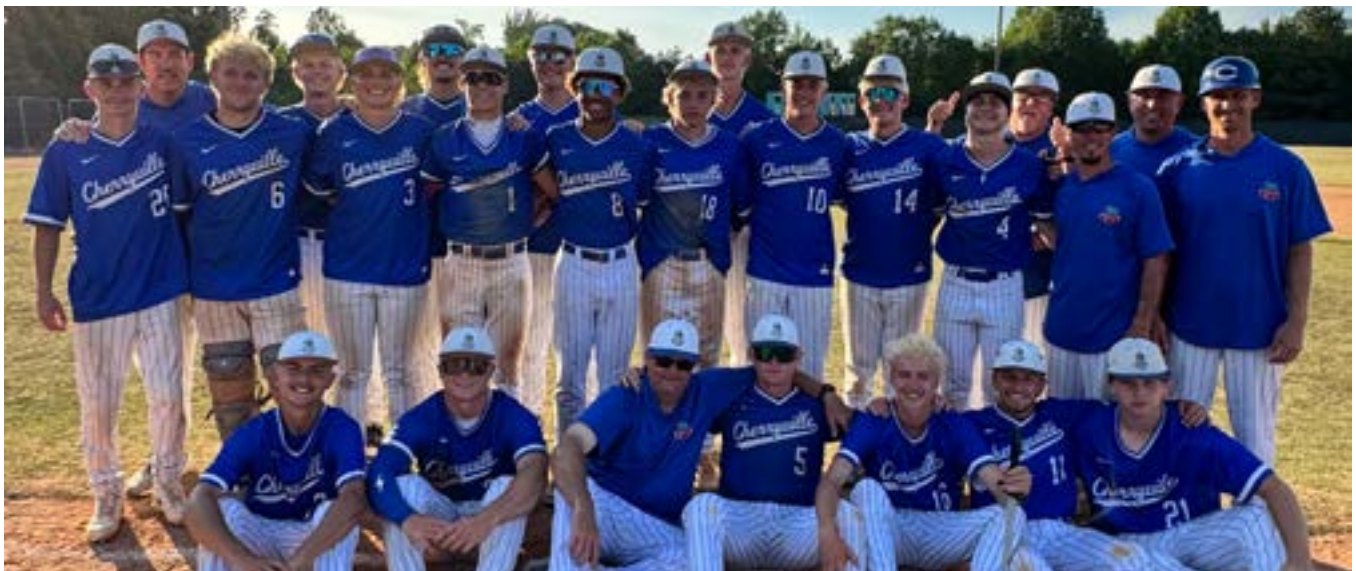

It was a huge moment for the team, school and community as well as a confidence builder moving forward.

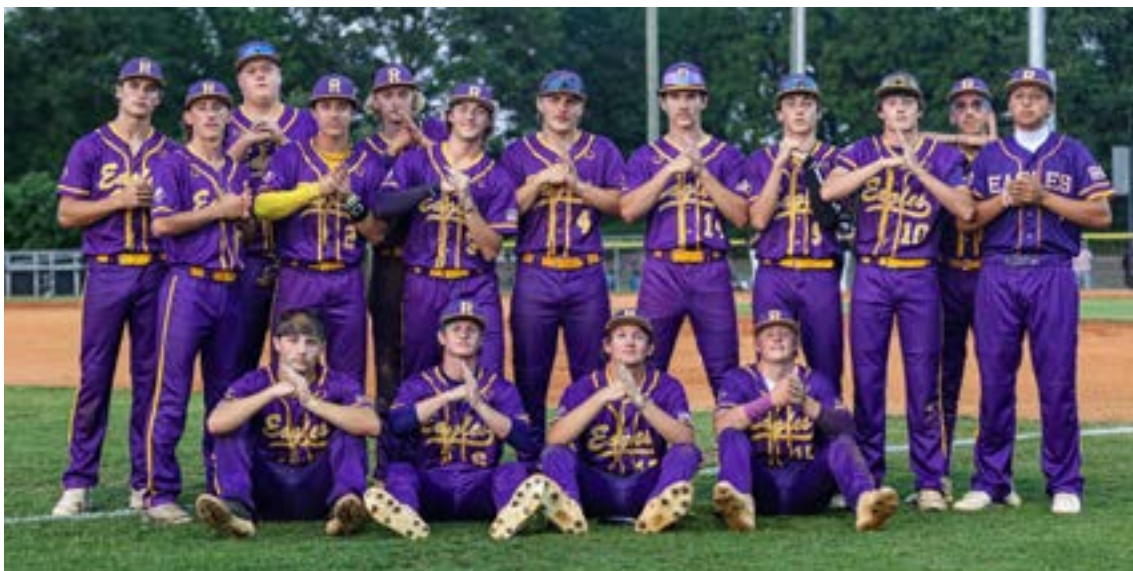
